

Established in 1998 as Confinity, PayPal had its initial public offering in 2002, and became a wholly owned subsidiary of eBay later that year. eBay spun off PayPal in 2015.

The company ranked 204th on the 2019 Fortune 500 of the largest United States corporations by revenue. As of 2020, PayPal operates in 202 markets and has 305 million active, registered accounts and 21,800 employees. PayPal allows customers to send, receive, and hold funds in 25 currencies worldwide.

### THIS WEEK'S MEETING:

Our own Majed Chaaban welcomed a crowd of us at his place of employment, PayPal, where we dined on lunches from Ken's HB Hams, courtesy of PayPal! What a nice—and unexpected-- treat!

Olaf Schweidler, Senior Director of Global Financial Services at PayPal, told us some of the company's history and explained how it works. Surely we are all aware of the ease of using PayPal for online purchases—(and for paying our Rotary dues ©). It's so much easier than typing in a 12-digit account number, expiration date, & CVV code. Just link it to a credit or debit card. (The Bill Me Later service gives the merchant payment in full while the buyer has a grace period to pay.)

Businesses cannot only accept payments but also get financing via a PayPal Business Loan --A fixed term loan based on a full picture of the business, automatically repaid with a predictable weekly payment; Funding as fast as the next business day; Competitively-priced, fixed fee known in advance; Predictable, weekly payments automatically debited from the business's bank account--or via PayPal Working Capital -- A loan primarily based on PayPal account history, automatically repaid with a share of PayPal sales. (Minimum payment required.); Application, approval, and funding in just minutes; Affordable fixed fee known in advance; Repaid automatically with a percentage of each PayPal sale until the balance is paid in full. Minimum payment required every 90 days. Learned something new today. Thanks, Olaf! And many thanks for the lunch, PayPal!
