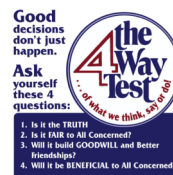
Nice to see **Jerry Neppi**—a returning member???. **Jerry** told us about his newest venture. His guest, **Jenn Pak**, is a graphic designer.
