About today's meeting: Susan Baker is an epidemiologist specializing in injury prevention, the first director of the Johns Hopkins Center for Injury Research and Policy. Her research includes motor vehicle occupant and pedestrian deaths among children and adults; fatalities related to aviation, motorcycles, and heavy trucks; carbon monoxide poisoning; drowning; childhood asphyxiation; house fires; falls in the elderly; homicide; suicide; fatal occupational injuries; and injury severity scoring. Professor Baker is an ardent advocate of policy changes that will prevent injuries. Much of her teaching and research is designed to influence the legislators, administrators, media representatives, and others whose decisions can determine the likelihood of injury for thousands of people. The main thrust of Sue's talk was the need to have safety as the first consideration in any new product design (or design change) the intended use, the anticipated use, and the likely abuse. As Dan pointed out, "You can't fix stupid." People don't heed warnings.
